**THE 7th GENERAL ASSEMBLY
OF THE TURKIC UNIVERSITIES UNION
OF THE ORGANIZATION OF TURKIC STATES**

REPORT

The 7th General Assembly of the Turkic Universities Union of the Organization of Turkic States (hereinafter referred as the "TURKUNIB") was held on 20 May 2024 in Baku, Azerbaijan. Azerbaijan State University of Economics (UNEC), the current Chair University-in-Office of the TURKUNIB hosted the event. The Program and Agenda of the meeting are attached herewith as *Annex 1* and *Annex 2*.

The General Assembly was attended by high-level officials, University Rectors, Vice-Rectors, and representatives of the member universities of the Union, as well as the delegation of the Secretariat of the Organization of Turkic States (list of participants enclosed - *Annex 3*).

H.E. Ambassador Kubanychbek Omuraliev, the Secretary General of the Organization of Turkic States (OTS), H.E. Hasan Hasanli, the Deputy Minister of Science and Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan, H.E. Prof. Dr. Shahin Mustafayev, the President of the Turkic Academy, delivered speeches at the Opening Session of the General Assembly that was moderated by Prof. Dr. Adalat Muradov, Rector of the UNEC, the Chair University-in-Office of the TURKUNIB.

Prof. Dr. Adalat Muradov, Rector of the UNEC, welcomed the participants and informed about the activities conducted during the chairmanship of the UNEC at TURKUNIB in 2023-2024. He referred to successful organization of the Special Meeting of the Rectors of TURKUNIB on 6-7 June 2023 in Samarkand, within which Prof. Dr. Aziz Sanjar, the Nobel Laureate, made a comprehensive online introduction where he addressed the participants his valuable recommendations in the field of science and education. The Rector of the UNEC also informed that during the Chairmanship, interest for the membership at TURKUNIB has significantly increased and the number of universities from the OTS countries which applied for the membership reached 60. The Rector also briefed participants about the history and activities of the Turkic World Economics faculty which was introduced in 1992, as well as the Turkic World Economic Research Center established in 2018 within the UNEC. Prof. Dr. Adalat Muradov also recalled that in 2023 the special edition of the Scientific Journal "UNEC Expert" dedicated to the theme "Organization of Turkic States: Economic Potential and Future Vision" was issued.

He also made a presentation on the necessity of introduction of an efficient mechanism for coordinating the activities of the TURKUNIB and its further institutionalization. He also mentioned that the issues such as main priorities, targets, status and relationship with the OTS, financing, reforms for ensuring efficient activity of Orkhun Exchange Program, criteria for TURKUNIB membership, decision-making procedures, secretarial functions within the Union, as well as responding to opportunities and challenges posed by the digitalization in the modern

era should be addressed. In this regard, making amendments to the Directive on the establishment of the Turkic Universities Union seems to be necessary.

During the session, H.E. Ambassador Kubanychbek Omuraliev, the Secretary General of the OTS, emphasized that the main goal is not just to cooperate within the framework of established platforms within the OTS, but to develop concrete results, mechanisms and products that could be used by the students and academicians, and proposed to be actively involved in discussing the ways for further strengthening and institutionalization of TURKUNIB.

Addressing the audience, H.E. Hasan Hasanli, the Deputy Minister of Science and Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan underlined the significance of activities of the OTS, as well as the mutual support among the Member States of the OTS. He also highlighted the necessity to include the recommendations of the General Assembly on the proposals by the Turkish side into the agenda of the upcoming Meeting of the Ministers of Education of the OTS to be held on 1 June 2024 in Shusha, Republic of Azerbaijan.

H.E. Prof. Dr. Shahin Mustafayev, the President of the Turkic Academy emphasized the necessity to improve and strengthen the Union, as well as Orkhun Exchange Program. He also highlighted that recently the Turkic Investment Fund was established and the TURKUNIB could use this opportunity to get financial support from the Fund through reflecting relevant item in the Declaration of the OTS Summit. He also proposed that the participants should negotiate and agree on the texts of the concept papers submitted by the Turkish side in order to achieve concrete deliverables of the General Assembly.

After the Opening Ceremony, the participants started the session of discussions on the agenda items of the 7th General Assembly of TURKUNIB, which was moderated by Sadi Jafarov, the OTS Deputy Secretary General.

Adoption of the agenda.

The participants reviewed the draft Agenda of the General Assembly prepared by the Secretariat and the Chair University-in-Office of the TURKUNIB. The Parties acknowledged that the Chairmanship of the UNEC in TURKUNIB will end in November 2024, and therefore decided to delete the item regarding the Road Map on activities of the TURKUNIB. Then the participants adopted the updated Agenda (items below):

I. Discussion on modalities regarding the improvement of the Turkic Universities Union:

- Proposals of the Turkish side on strengthening the TURKUNIB;

II. Discussion on the new membership applications of the universities to the Union;

III. Any other issue.

I. Discussion on modalities regarding the improvement of the Turkic Universities Union.

The Secretariat, referring to the discussion held within the 9th Senior Official Meeting of the Ministries of Education of the OTS held on 13 June 2023, and the 7th Meeting of the Ministers of Education of the OTS held on 14 June 2023 held in Samarkand, informed that the Turkish side (Council of Higher Education of the Republic of Türkiye) made proposals on strengthening the TURKUNIB and Orkhun Exchange Program. The Secretariat also recalled that those proposals and relevant concept papers were submitted for consideration of the

Member States through the official notes of the OTS Secretariat (1) *Note-2023-493 dated 20.06.2023*; 2) *Note-2023-979 dated 17.11.2023*; 3) *Note-2024-1517 dated 17.05.2024*).

The Secretariat also informed that at the current stage there were 49 member universities of the TURKUNIB, however there was a growing interest for the membership, and in such a situation a better coordination and strengthened institutionalization within TURKUNIB is absolutely necessary.

In this regard, representatives from certain universities from Türkiye requested to deliver the presentations on the concept papers on the above-mentioned proposals put forward by the Turkish side. Based on these requests the following presentations were made at the General Assembly:

- Amendments to the Directive on the Establishment of the Turkic Universities Union and Higher Education Area, presented by H.E. Prof. Dr. Musa Yıldız, Rector of Gazi University;
- Turkic World Higher Education Data Bank Establishment Project, presented by H.E. Prof. Dr. Mustafa Kurt, Rector of Marmara University;
- Turkic World Association for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (TWAQA), presented by H.E. Prof. Dr. Necdet Budak, Rector of Ege University;
- Ensuring Certification or Equivalency of Diplomas among Member universities of the Turkic Universities Union, presented by H.E. Prof. Dr. Nurullah Okumuş, Rector of Afyonkarahisar Health Sciences University;
- Organization of Turkic States Higher Education Foundation, presented by H.E. Prof. Dr. Ferudun Yilmaz, Rector of Bursa Uludağ University.

The concept papers concerning the initiatives on the above-mentioned presentations are attached herewith (*Annex 4*).

All participants welcomed the presentations by the Turkish side. They underlined that the process of institutionalization within the TURKUNIB is necessary, and relevant work on elaboration of the proposals and concept presented shall be carried out in the forthcoming period with the participation of the representatives of the OTS Member States. In this regard, a relevant road map describing the steps to be taken could be useful.

In the course of the meeting, H.E. Prof. Dr. Zhanseit Tuimebayev, Rector of the Al-Farabi University, and H.E. Elmira Idrysova, Vice-Rector of the Akhmet Yassawi University, referred to the initiative by H.E. Kassym-Jomart Tokayev, the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan, to create a Network University of the OTS. He informed the participants that the creation of the Network University of the OTS involves the development of flexible mechanisms for interaction between the universities of the Union, in analogy with the Network university of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization. In this regard, the Rector suggested to include the subject on establishment of the Network University in the agenda of the forthcoming Meeting of the Ministers of Education of the OTS to be held on 1 June 2024 in Shusha, Republic of Azerbaijan.

II. Discussion on the new membership applications of the universities to the Union.

The Secretariat informed the participants that it officially received 60 applications to become a member university of the TURKUNIB through the Ministries of Foreign Affairs of the OTS Member and Observer States. The Secretariat also highlighted that according to Article 10 of the Directive on the establishment of the Turkic Universities Union and Higher Education

Area, admission to membership is decided by simple majority vote. In this regard, voting on the acceptance of new member universities was held and the participants took a unanimous decision on accepting 60 new member universities to the Turkic Universities Union of the OTS. The list of the new member universities is attached herewith (*Annex No. 5*).

III. Any other issue.

Under this item, the participants held a discussion on the new Chairman University-in-Office of the TURKUNIB for 2025-2026. In this regard, the Secretariat recalled that according to the Article 6 of the Directive on the establishment of the Turkic Universities Union and Higher Education Area, the chairmanship in-Office is elected by simple majority for two years at the Meeting of the General Assembly among the member universities.

The Secretariat informed the participants that up until now, the chairmanship was conducted by the universities from Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Türkiye. In this regard, the candidacy from amongst the universities of Uzbekistan can be considered. The Uzbek universities expressed their position that they will need more time for the consultations on this subject.

At the same time, the Hacettepe University and Bahçeşehir University expressed their readiness to take the Chairmanship of the TURKUNIB for 2025-2026. In summary, three options on the new chairmanship were put on the agenda (University that Uzbek side might propose, Hacettepe University, or Bahçeşehir University). The participants of the General Assembly, taking into consideration the current proposals on the new chairmanship, decided that any of these 3 options in principle will be acceptable to them.

In this regard, it was decided that the consultations among the participants will continue in a working manner and a decision on the new chairmanship will be based on one of the above-mentioned three proposals. The Secretariat will inform the Parties on the final decision regarding the Chair University-in-Office of the TURKUNIB through official channels at a later stage.

The participants of the TURKUNIB General Assembly, as well as the Secretariat of the OTS expressed their gratitude to Prof. Dr. Adalat Muradov, the Rector of the UNEC and his team for excellent organization of the 7th General Assembly of the TURKUNIB and for their warm hospitality.

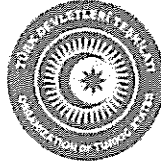

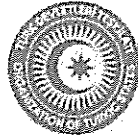

**ENHANCING COOPERATION
WITHIN THE TURKIC HIGHER EDUCATION AREA
PROPOSALS BY TÜRKİYE**

(to be submitted to TURKUNIB General Assembly, Baku 20 May 2024)

On June 14, 2023, in Samarkand, Uzbekistan, during the Organization of Turkic States Education Ministers' meeting, the Turkish delegation stated that there was a need to strengthen cooperation within the Turkic Higher Education Area.

In this regard, Türkiye proposed the creation of a common data bank to facilitate the exchange of faculty and students; mentioned the foundation's establishment, emphasized the external evaluation quality assurance and accreditation processes, and signaled the significance of certifying education received, providing certification, and ensuring diploma equivalency.

Under the coordination of the Council of Higher Education, Türkiye has produced concept papers on the proposals made in Samarkand following an extensive consultation process with pertinent higher education institutions and a thorough study carried out by specialists.

The concept papers that are attached will be discussed at the Organization of Turkic States (OTS) Turkic Universities Union meeting in Baku on May 20, 2024. The ultimate goal is to present the concept papers to the OTS Education Ministers on June 1, 2024, for approval, and to receive a tasking on furthering the work in this regard at the next OTS Summit.

Turkic World Higher Education Data Bank Establishment Project

1. Objective

It is aimed to establish a common data bank to facilitate the exchange of students and faculty members between the Turkic States coordinated by the Turkic Council Turkic Universities Union affiliated with the Organization of Turkic States within the framework of the published Regulation and to increase information sharing and cooperation.

2. Legal Basis

All processes and regulations regarding the Orhun Exchange Program are explained in detail in the TURKISH COUNCIL TURKIC UNIVERSITIES UNION (TÜRKÜNİB) ORHUN EXCHANGE PROGRAM REGULATION: <http://turkunib.org/tr/orhun>

3. Preamble

Within the scope of the Orhun Exchange Program carried out by the Turkic Council Turkic Universities Union in line with the regulations, the rules pertaining to student and faculty mobility, the requirements to be met by students, the evaluation process of applications, course equivalences, the processes to be followed at various stages in the exchange program and the financial resources of the exchange program are defined in detail. Higher education institutions that have signed the Orhun Exchange Program Protocol and have thus become parties to the Protocol are included in the Program in question. Member countries of the Union are declared on the TÜRKÜNİB website. However;

- *There is no introductory information on the Union's website regarding the faculties, departments, institutes, undergraduate and graduate programs and research infrastructures of the universities that are members of TÜRKÜNİB and parties to the Orhun Program.*
- *In addition, there is no information regarding the program on the basis of which the cooperation is made on the Union's website.*

Transferring the above-mentioned information to a Common Data Bank and sharing it with students and faculty members willing to be involved in the Program will facilitate mobility.

4. Data Bank Design for Academic and Educational Mobility

It is convenient to prepare the data bank which is planned to be designed with the aim of encouraging and facilitating academic and educational mobility in a modular architecture. First of all, it is recommended to develop three basic modules on the basis of mobility protocols concerning educational mobility for students, as well as mobility for faculty and administrative staff. Since the mobility objectives, selection and placement processes, mobility periods and funding sources of students, faculty and administrative staff are different, it would be appropriate and useful to develop different modules. In addition to these modules, it is important to design a module for grant of funding resources and a separate module for internship mobility.

4.1 Module for Protocols concerning Educational Mobility

It is a module that contains the protocols created between TÜRKÜNİB member universities and the detailed information pertaining thereto. The key information that should be included in the table to be prepared in the educational mobility module is as follows:

- Name of the universities with which mutual protocols have been created
- Unique identification code/number of the university: It refers to the unique identification code/number that each university and research institution in the member countries of the Organization of Turkic States will have. All universities and research institutions will carry out their transactions within the portal through this identification code/number. Under this code/number, the programs, research centers, scientific projects, personnel information and campus infrastructure information of the university and research center will be aligned.
- School/Faculty/Institute for which a protocol is made in each university
- Name of the program carried out at the School/ Faculty/Institute where the mobility will take place
- Program level where the mobility will take place (associate degree, undergraduate or graduate degree)
- Accreditation information regarding the program and/or institution where the mobility will take place
- Incoming and outgoing student quota allocated to universities within the scope of the Protocol
- Allowed student mobility period
- Link information regarding the academic calendars of universities
- Information regarding applications for lodging / dormitories etc.

A sample table of the protocols for educational mobility module is presented in Annex 1.

4.2 Module for Protocols concerning Faculty Mobility

Faculty (Academic Staff) Mobility should be aimed at teaching courses and/or conducting joint research. The following key data are required in the Faculty Mobility module:

- Name of the universities with which mutual protocols have been created
- Unique identification code/number of the university
- Name of the College/Faculty/Department where the mobility will take place
- Allowed mobility period
- Level of the program in which courses will be taught (Associate, Undergraduate or Graduate)
- Accreditation information regarding the program and/or institution where the mobility will take place
- Allocated quota for academic staff
- Link information regarding the academic calendars of universities
- Information regarding applications for lodging / dormitories etc.

A sample table containing this information is presented in Annex 2. In addition, in the Faculty Mobility Module, the details to be considered in the application process must be presented in a pdf file (Factsheet file) in each line of the Protocol. Thus, the legal regulations applied in each

country and the issues to be considered should be brought to the attention of the relevant faculty member before the mobility process.

4.3 Module for Protocols concerning Administrative Staff Mobility

Administrative Staff Mobility should be aimed at sharing experience regarding the processes implemented in the field of higher education. The following key data is required in the Administrative Staff Mobility module:

- Name of the universities with which mutual protocols have been created
- Unique identification code/number of the university
- Name of the unit where the mobility will take place
- Allowed mobility period
- Accreditation information regarding the program and/or institution where the mobility will take place
- Allocated quota for administrative staff
- Information regarding applications for lodging / dormitories etc.

The details to be considered in the application process must be presented in a pdf file (Factsheet file) in each line of the Protocol. Thus, the legal regulations applied in each country and the issues to be considered should be brought to the attention of the relevant administrative staff before the mobility process.

4.4 Granting Module for Mobility

The types of grants to be offered to support the mobility of students and faculty, types of financial resources (Organization of Turkic States, Universities, etc.), grant conditions and similar information should be explained specifically for the University or Country in question in the module.

4.5 Internship Mobility Module for Students

Although internship mobility is not planned within the scope of the Orhun Program, such mobility opportunities are important for students to gain professional experience. In this module, information as regards the legal legislation that the student must comply with in the country where he/she will visit to perform internship mobility, institutions or companies where the internship can take place (sector, city, etc.), and mobility period should be included.

5. Additional Modules to be Included in the Turkic World Higher Education Data Bank

In addition to data bank modules that will facilitate process management within the scope of student and faculty mobility, sharing current data between universities in the following areas will help increase strategic collaborations between institutions.

5.1 Legislation Module

A module that includes information as regards the education policies of member countries, regulations, directives, application procedures and principles applied in universities can be designed. This module would provide access to legislation and policy texts with smart search capability ensuring the recognition and visibility of education models implemented in countries.

Such a database would form the basis for cooperation and the formation of a common culture in the Turkic World Higher Education institutions.

5.2 Research Infrastructures Module

This module would contain statistical information and data on all aspects such as departments/programs, classrooms and laboratories, physical facilities and geographical location, faculty members, students and similar assets of the higher education institutions of the member countries.

With this module, a significant contribution would be made to the development of the Turkic World Higher Education by creating the infrastructure of joint research opportunities, as well as introductory information about research laboratories, capacity, devices and data on experiments and research to be conducted in laboratories.

5.3 Research Units and Researcher Module

Information as regards all researchers, especially faculty members, of member countries, would be registered and links to information about researchers' CVs, fields of study, works, projects and similar information would mutually be provided.

With the help of this database, researchers can conduct joint research of higher quality and develop large-scale joint projects throughout the Turkic World.

5.4 Joint Education Programs Module

Data regarding joint education programs developed by universities of member countries for double degrees would be included under this module. Course schedules, courses offered, information about students registered in the program, students' final course grades and transcripts would be shared mutually through such a database.

5.5 Current Collaborations Module

Chronological data and statistical information regarding education, research and mobility among the universities of member countries would be included under this module.

6. Data Bank Design Process

Data bank working processes should be designed in such a way as to include the following basic steps:

- Definition phase of data structures: The board consisting of representatives of member countries defines data structures and criteria appropriate to the objectives defined in the policy texts.
- Data model phase: Data models that support defined evaluation criteria are designed and standardized.
- Data collection: Data flow is initiated by implementing the required service/API developments to ensure the data flow of member institutions.

- Analysis and reporting: Member institutions can receive reporting and analyses results at certain standards.
- Standardization: Standardization and harmonization activities to be carried out by and between universities in member countries are important for the effective execution of the process. As a result of standardization, student and faculty exchange programs can be implemented. The achievements of student exchange programs announced periodically, the results of joint research collaborations and academic activities can be monitored and reported. The scope of the standardization process is listed below:

- 1) Standards and data models are defined to ensure inter-operability of information systems and educational technologies for higher education institutions, thereby creating a common language of communication for all relevant information systems.
- 2) In addition to providing open data, a platform that countries' policy-making institutions, educational institutions, faculty members and students can register with provides tools (authentication and level-based authorization) appropriate to the user profile.
- 3) The creation of working and communication groups focused on defined goals ensures the execution of activities, periodical reporting of outputs and chronological indexing and storage in the database, as well as the publication of data (open data, corporate data, data restricted to user profile, etc.) according to the authority level.
- 4) It provides services that will enable data flow from the information systems of institutions registered in the system. With the help of these services, data addition, deletion and updating are carried out within the framework of determined standards. Institutions transfer data from their information systems to the Turkic World Higher Education Data Bank by using services appropriate to their authority level.
- 5) Turkic World Higher Education Data Bank will support the local languages of the countries. It will provide language support for languages used outside member countries (English, Russian, etc.) for open data.
- 6) Analyses and reports are published according to the authority level of the member institutions. Analyses and reports published within the scope of open data are published without authority restrictions.
- 7) It defines the standards and structure of data models that will support the evaluation criteria and reports to be hosted in the Turkic World Higher Education Data Bank. Data standards can be established for the compatibility of qualifications, academic competence and other achievements.
- 8) It defines standards for course syllabus and curriculum compatibility.
- 9) It defines the conditions and standards required for course and credit recognition and transfer.

10) It allows the creation of badge and certificate systematic infrastructure and standards, compatible with the open badge standard and signed with verifiable identity for education, research activities and the outputs thereof.

11) It defines the standards to be adopted in assessment and analysis.

12) It defines the requirements and standards for research activities.

ENSURING CERTIFICATION OR EQUIVALENCY OF DIPLOMAS AMONG MEMBER UNIVERSITIES OF THE TURKIC UNIVERSITIES UNION

Certification and Equivalence of Diplomas

For the realization of the objectives of the Union, it is crucial to certify the education received, to provide certification, and to ensure the equivalency of diplomas. With this aim, the following suggestions have been presented to the Union.

1. Ensuring Equivalency of Diplomas: Firstly, the proposal of "implementing a common credit transfer system," which is among the goals of the Union, should be put into practice as soon as possible. This common credit system should be the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS), which is already in use in EU countries. ECTS facilitates inter-institutional equivalency and credit transfer processes since it demonstrates the equivalence of learning outcomes in a higher education program to those in another university, either within the same country or abroad. Implementation of ECTS, or a similar system to be developed, by all member universities will greatly facilitate recognition.

With this purpose, "Scientific Field Advisory Committees" should be established by the Union as soon as possible, with the participation of expert academics from member universities. These committees should evaluate the curricula and the essential outcomes (professional and academic) related to the common fields of study at member universities. Thus, similarities and differences between curricula will be identified for use in equivalency evaluations, making the assessment process faster and easier.

Regarding equivalency of diplomas, a board named "**Organization of Turkic States Universities Equivalency Board**" should be established within the Union with the participation of academics selected from member universities in various fields. This board will oversee and report on the correct implementation of equivalency processes. After a thorough examination of the applications submitted to the board, the following steps will be taken:

- If the content of the program, duration of study, medium of instruction, essential outcomes, theoretical and practical courses, credits (e.g. ECTS), and internship processes are equivalent, and if the program from which the applicant graduated is recognized by the higher education council of the country to be applied (for example, YÖK for Türkiye) or by the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME), or accredited by institutions with the authority to do so, the

Equivalency Board will grant approval. However, the final approval will be obtained from the higher education institution in the country to be applied, along with an eligibility report.

- If the concerned university is ranked within the top 750 in World Rankings a "direct equivalency" may be granted for the respective program. In such cases, the Board will conduct a preliminary evaluation and grant initial approval, after which the final approval will still be obtained from the higher education institution in the country to be applied.
- If the content of the program, duration of study, medium of instruction, essential outcomes, theoretical and practical courses, credits, and internship processes are not equivalent, and/or if the program from which the applicant graduated is not recognized by the higher education council of the country to be applied or by WFME, or if it is not accredited by institutions with the authority to do so, the Equivalency Board will definitively reject such applications without forwarding it to the higher education institution in the country to be applied.
- If any deficiencies are identified or doubts arise regarding the duration of study, theoretical and practical courses, credits, and internship processes related to the program from which the applicant graduated, the application will be forwarded to the higher education institution in the country to be applied for final approval, with the condition of completion of the deficiencies. This may involve practices such as completing missing courses, internships, projects, clinical practices, or taking additional exams, depending on the content of the program, to ensure the acquisition of essential outcomes.

Furthermore, a Union Education and Certification Database will be created by registering the diplomas and certificates issued by member universities into a common database. Such a database will also enhance employment opportunities. Additionally, when examining the websites of universities that are members of the Turkic Universities Union, it is observed that, alongside the respective national languages of the countries, there are options for English and Russian languages. Adding Turkish as another language option to the websites of the member universities will facilitate communication as it is one of the common languages of the Union. In fact, we suggest that Turkish and English be designated as the common languages of the Union.

2. Certification: Within the Union, a "Certification Programs Commission" similar to the "Organization of Turkic States Universities Equivalency Board" should be established. Each member country will notify this commission of the certificate programs offered in various fields of science.

According to this proposal, the Commission will determine and list standardized certification programs, specifying their scope, objectives, content, and other various processes. Subsequently, it will annually announce the certification programs that can be offered jointly among member countries. The country offering the certification program will allocate a certain quota to other member countries for each program. Once applications for these certification programs are received from all countries, the Commission will enroll students or graduates in the programs, ensuring equal distribution among the applying countries. The certification documents awarded at the end of the program will be unconditionally accepted by other member universities.

Diploma Registration and Employment: Each country has different legislation and practices regarding diploma registration and employment processes in addition to diploma equivalency, based on different professional groups. Therefore, the initiative regarding the employment of citizens of member countries who have obtained diploma equivalency should be left entirely to the legislation, employment conditions, and decisions taken by the upper management of the concerned member country.

In order to facilitate the employment of citizens of member countries who have obtained diploma equivalency in other member countries, a detailed information page should be created on the TÜRKÜNİB website for each country regarding diploma registration and professional practices based on different professional groups. Furthermore, a Union Education and Certification Database will be established by registering the diplomas and certificates issued by member universities into a common database. Such a database will increase employment opportunities. To further enhance these processes, it is essential to invest in technological infrastructure. In addition to all of these, informative seminars and workshops should be organized in member countries regarding equivalency processes, certification, and education standards to increase transparency and comprehensibility of the processes.

**Letter of Intent
for
"Organization of Turkic States (OTS) Higher Education
Foundation"**

In order to develop and deepen cooperation between member countries in the field of higher education, one of the suggestions presented in the Turkic World 2040 Vision Document adopted at the 8th Heads of State Summit of the "Organization of Turkic States" is the establishment of the Organization of Turkic States Higher Education Foundation. The aims of the foundation are stated below:

- 1) To ensure the execution of joint projects in line with the purpose of the Foundation in cooperation with universities of the member and observer countries of the Organization of Turkic States.
- 2) To support the most comprehensive sharing of the opportunities and capabilities (libraries, laboratories, workshops, sports facilities, etc.) of the universities of the Organization of Turkic States member and observer countries within the framework of bilateral and multiple protocols and cooperation agreements.
- 3) To contribute to supporting and financing student, researcher, and academic staff mobility, mainly through the Orhun Exchange Program.
- 4) To create standard policies in the higher education field of the Organization of Turkish States.
- 5) To provide education scholarships for students, determine objective criteria, and allocate scholarships to students.
- 6) To contribute to the development of the skills of academic and administrative staff through exchange.
- 7) To support TÜRKÜNİB's education, research & development, and community support activities.
- 8) To contribute to the sharing of best practices in entrepreneurship and vocational education and to explore opportunities for the implementation of joint projects to increase knowledge and skills to this end.
- 9) To establish joint universities aligning with the TDT mission through bilateral or multilateral international agreements within the borders of the Organization of Turkic States.

10) To establish joint student dormitories within the borders of the Organization of Turkic States.

11) To create and increase the regular Foundation resources provided by the member countries of the Organization and to ensure the provision of opportunities and services according to the contribution rates of the countries.

In matters that fall directly or indirectly within the scope of the duty of the Foundation to be established, the following issues regarding general strategy and planning should be taken into account:

1. To confirm that exchange students participating in the Orhun Exchange Program—designed to facilitate student and faculty exchange among higher education institutions within the TURKUNIB network—cannot to receive any financial contributions from their host universities beyond the tuition fees paid to their home institutions.
2. To facilitate the membership of universities to the Orhun Exchange Program in order to provide student exchange, scholarship, and discount facilities and to promote scholarships and similar facilities in the universities of the countries that are members of the Organization of Turkic States,
3. To ensure that Orhun exchange students benefit primarily from scholarships and discounts by increasing the exchange quotas, which were limited when the Organization of the Turkic States Higher Education Foundation was established,
4. Establishing common state dormitories regarding accommodation, which is the primary problem of exchange students, allocating special scholarships to students and providing the necessary facilities by the host member country,
5. To rearrange the 2% quota for foreign nationals in the Credit and Dormitories Institution to exclude students from OTS member countries,
6. To encourage discount policies in order to encourage language learning of students coming to Türkiye from member and observer countries,

7. Giving priority in scholarship opportunities to exchange students desiring to learn the language of the host country,
8. To pay attention to the balanced distribution of scholarships in proportion to the population of member countries,
9. Maintaining quality standards by evaluating students' grade point averages and other success criteria in awarding scholarships.
10. To promote awareness by providing scholarships to students of different universities from member countries,
11. To provide a specific discount for international students from member countries of the Organization of Turkic States (such as EU universities' fee differentiation between member and non-member countries);
12. To encourage the expansion of discounts to include foundation universities.

Turkic World Association for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (TWAQA)**Background:**

The establishment of the "Turkic World Association for Quality Assurance in Higher Education" as an independent body to provide services to external evaluation quality assurance and accreditation processes of member agencies to the Association, which is stated in the 7(j) of the "Directive on the Establishment of the Association of Turkish Universities and Higher Education Area" with the aim of showing the goals of the Association. Additionally, it is important to ensure that the future external evaluation standards determined within the scope of the mission and vision of the Association are compatible with international accreditation standards in line with the expression "Adaptation of higher education programs to international accreditation standards" in the mentioned 7(b) of the Directive.

Mission/Vision:

It is essential primarily to determine the mission and vision of the Association, which is assumed to be an umbrella organization responsible for coordinating higher education quality assurance activities throughout the Turkic World, similar to ENQA. In line with this mission and vision, the following steps need to be taken:

Structure:

The founding members of the Association should be National Agencies recognized at the national and international levels and selected in accordance with the objectives and defined criteria of the Association. After determining the founding members, it will be necessary to establish the General Assembly, Management and Executive Boards, Secretariat, and specialized personnel in various fields such as quality assurance, policy analysis, research, and administration of the Association's activities.

First Step:

Subsequently, within this structure, it is necessary to establish standards and guidelines for the The Union will be established under TÜRKÜNİB, initially consisting of a president, vice president, and general secretariat within a presidential model. Subsequently, within this structure, it is necessary to establish standards and guidelines for the Union that are in compliance with international accreditation standards. These standards could be under three main headings, similar to ENQA practices:

1. Standards for Internal Quality Assurance
2. Standards for External Quality Assurance
3. Standards for Quality Assurance

Agencies Once these standards are determined, membership applications from member countries will be accepted. After the acceptance of member agencies, it will be necessary to form the Union's General Assembly, Management and Executive Boards, Secretariat, and specialized personnel in various fields such as quality assurance, policy analysis, research, and administration, in line with the activities to be carried out.

Membership Acceptance:

After the establishment of the agency and the determination of standards, the membership of national agencies from countries wishing to join the union will be accepted based on their compliance with the established Quality Standards, International Recognition, Quality Assurance System, Independence and Impartiality, Resource Adequacy, and Continuous Improvement and Development criteria.

Full Membership: Such membership may generally be open to quality assurance organizations operating at the national or international level and formally recognized by the relevant state/authoritative authority. These members will have the right to participate in decision-making processes and vote in the establishment of the Association.

Associate Membership: It may be open to organizations or institutions related to higher education quality assurance that do not meet the full membership criteria but generally operate at the regional or institutional level. These may include quality assurance organizations, associations, networks, or other relevant organizations.

Apart from "**Observer Membership**" organizations that are in the process of meeting the criteria for full membership status and are subject to external evaluations or reviews may be offered "**Candidate Membership**" status. Organizations or institutions that have a specific interest in higher education quality assurance but do not directly participate in quality assurance activities may be offered "**Associate Membership**" (e.g., universities, ministries of education, government agencies) opportunities.

Objectives and Goals:

The goals of the Association will be:

- 1.Enhancing Higher Education Quality Assurance: To assist in the development and improvement of higher education quality assurance systems throughout the Turkic World by determining, implementing, and evaluating quality assurance standards.
- 2.International Cooperation and Coordination: To work towards increasing the international acceptance and recognition of quality assurance systems in the Turkic World.
- 3.Supporting Member Agencies: To assist member agencies in enhancing their capacities and promoting collaboration among member agencies by sharing best practices.
- 4.Setting and Promoting Quality Assurance Standards: To lead the determination and dissemination of higher education quality assurance standards throughout the Turkic World.
- 5.Ensuring International Recognition: To ensure the international recognition and acceptance of member agencies.

Financial Resources:

The financial resources of the Association may consist of membership fees collected from member organizations, fees collected for services provided to members, income from projects, and sponsorships. Additionally, the Association may receive grants and donations from the Turkic World and other national or international organizations to support its activities.

DRAFT PROPOSALS FOR THE AMENDMENTS TO THE DIRECTIVE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE TURKIC UNIVERSITY UNION AND HIGHER EDUCATION AREA

The steps to be taken to transform the Turkic Universities Union into a more effective organization can be listed as follows:

Organizational Structure

- The mission, vision and strategy of the Union needs to be determined.
- The Union shall continue to be structured under the roof of Organization of Turkic States. The structure of the Union may be updated as follows:

Organs of the Union

- Turkic Universities Union Administration Structure: It consists of General Assembly, Board of Directors, Chairman, Secretariat and permanent units to be established under the Secretariat:

General Assembly

- General Assembly of Turkic Universities Union consists of university representatives from member countries. The member university representatives are the Rector, the relevant Vice Rector and one representative from the internationalization unit.
- The General Assembly convenes in a different country every year. The venue and date of the meeting is determined by the Board of Directors of the Union. The decisions taken by the General Assembly are binding and are implemented by the Board of Directors of the Union.

Board of Directors

- The Board of Directors consists of the Rectors to be determined by each state affiliated to Organization of Turkic States.
- The Chairman of the Board of Directors is elected among the Board of Directors for a certain period of time and the Board gathers every six months period.
- The Board of Directors needs to be accountable to the Organization of Turkic States Secretariat for all its actions. The Union's Board of Directors shall render decisions on the newly structured student and academic staff mobilities, quality assurance systems, and equivalency matters, and shall issue directives to the Secretariat of the Union and its subcommittees regarding their implementation.
- The Board of Directors establishes sub-working groups in fields such as Engineering, Healthcare, Literature, Medicine, Forestry, Aquatic Products, Economics, Theology, etc., with representatives from each member university so as to enhance effective collaboration among member universities when needed. The coordination and working principles of these groups shall be determined by the Board of Directors.
- Turkic Universities Union Congresses shall be organized to enhance cooperation, scientific activities, and cultural solidarity among Union academics. The themes, venues, and time periods of these congresses shall be determined by the Board of Directors.
- At the end of each year, the Board of Directors shall prepare an annual activity report and share it with the member universities.

Secretariat and Sub-Committees

- The Secretariat of the Union shall operate under the Board of Directors, actively managing the implementation of decisions and processes.
- The Secretariat shall make improvements to the Union's website, which will be prepared in both Turkish and English and hosted on the website of the Organization of Turkic States. Each member university's main webpage shall provide a link for easy access to the Union.
- Social media accounts for the Union shall be established for announcements and events. Communication through these accounts needs to be facilitated, and member universities are encouraged to follow them.
- The TÜRKÜNİB Secretariat shall work in coordination with the newly established subcommittees, providing requests and suggestions. The expenses, staff, and location support for the subcommittees shall be provided by the Organization of Turkic States.

The following sub-committees may be established under the Secretariat of Turkic Universities Union:

1. Turkic World Higher Education Databank,
2. Education-Training Committee,
3. Scientific Committee,
4. Turkic World Education Portal,
5. Higher Education Quality Assurance Board,
6. Sports-Culture Committee,
7. Student Council.

Union Membership

- Universities from member and observer states of the Organization of Turkic States, as well as non-member Turkic Republics and related communities may become members of the Turkic Universities Union.
- To become a member, universities must sign a declaration/commitment document prepared by the Union, which is subsequently submitted for approval by the General Assembly.
- To broaden the base of member universities within the Union, the entry of foundation universities into the system may be encouraged.
- Additionally, criteria for termination Union membership shall be established, along with a sanction mechanism.

Financial Structure

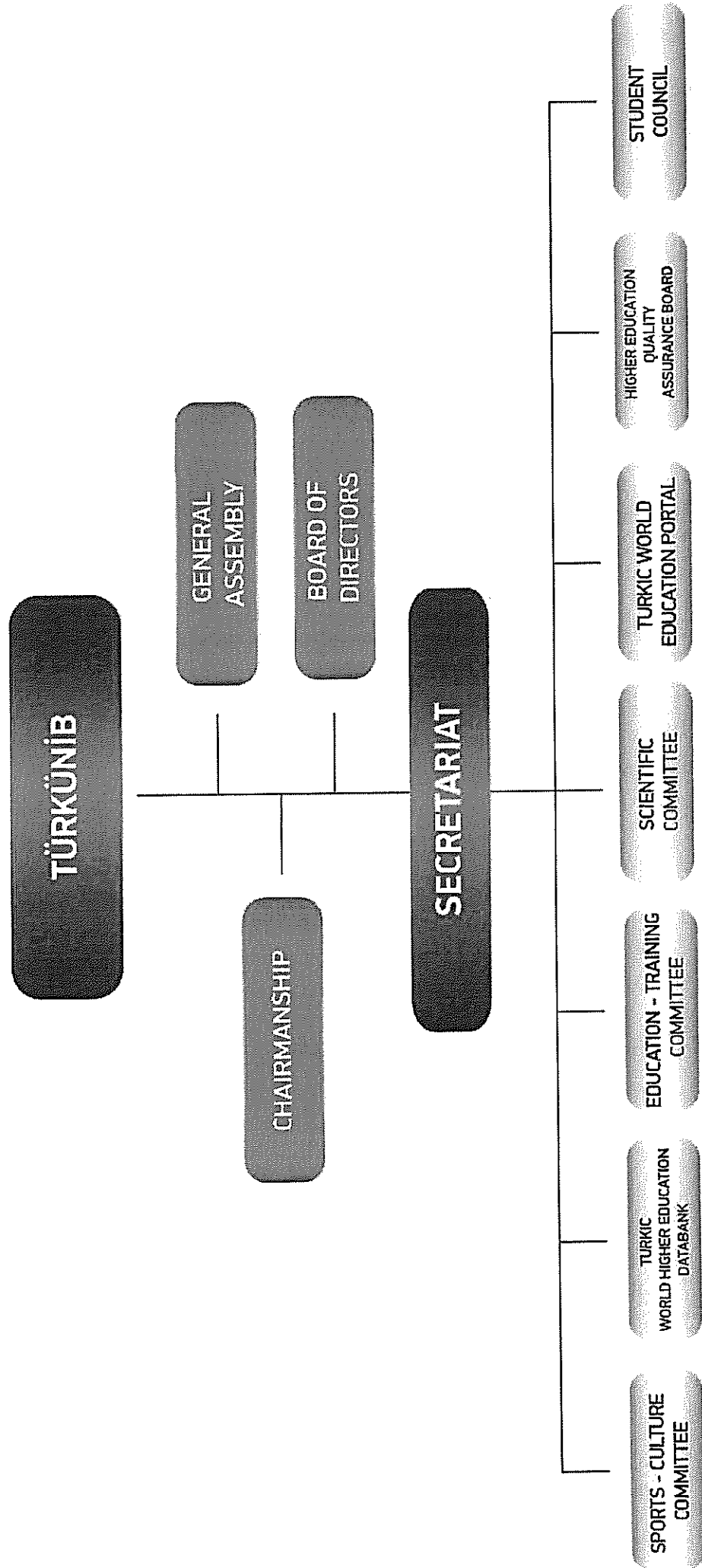
- To achieve the targeted processes within the Turkic Universities Union, implement new projects, and provide fund for Orkhun exchange programs, student and faculty mobilities, R&D projects, and researcher scholarships, a "Turkic States Organization Higher Education Fund" shall be established. This fund would facilitate resource transfers to member universities. The fund would be provided by member countries.

Responsibilities and Duties of the Union

- Undertaking required efforts to establish common standards (curricular unity) in educational programs to facilitate diploma equivalence, joint/dual diplomas, and student mobility in Turkic World Higher Education,
- Enabling functionality of the Orkhun Exchange Program,
- Engaging in joint R&D projects among Turkic World Universities to produce high-value-added products and a sustainable development model,

- Organizing annual Turkic World scientific congresses and educational fairs,
- Collaborating with institutions such as TÜRKSOY, YTB, Turkic Academy, TİKA, etc., to engage in joint activities,
- Establishing the "Turkic World E-Portal" to provide access to library facilities, scientific research, theses, and other publications in member countries,
- Strengthening the functionality of the Turkic Universities Union by creating a digital academic pool system focusing on scientific fields.

DIRECTIVE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE TURKIC UNIVERSITY UNION AND HIGHER EDUCATION AREA

PART I

Purpose, Scope, Reference and Definitions

Purpose

Article 1 - (1) The purpose of this Directive is to create the Higher Education Area of the Turkic Council by improving cooperation in higher education among the Turkic Council Member States.

(2) This Directive also intends to regulate structure, working principles and field of activities for the Turkic University Union established under the auspices of the Turkic Council.

Scope

Article 2 - (1) This Directive comprises procedures and principles of cooperation in higher education area to be made between the member universities of the Turkic Council Turkic University Union.

Reference

Article 3 - (1) This Directive has been prepared subject to the decisions taken at:

- a) the Second Summit of the Turkic Council held in Bishkek on August 23, 2012;
- b) the Meeting of Turkic Council Ministers of Education held in Colpan-Ata on August 10, 2012;
- c) the Preparatory Meeting of Turkic Council Turkic University Union held in Istanbul on 28-29 March 2012.
- d) the First General Assembly of the Turkic Universities Union held in Erzurum on October 16-17, 2014;
- e) the Third Meeting of Education Ministers held in Baku on November 28, 2014;
- f) the Fourth Meeting of Education Ministers held in Astana on September 5, 2015;
- g) the Fifth Meeting of Education Ministers held in Bishkek on March 15, 2019;
- h) the Sixth Meeting of Education Ministers held in Istanbul on November 4, 2021;
- i) the Seventh Meeting of Education Ministers held in Samarkand on June 14, 2023;
- j) the Sixth General Assembly of the Turkic Universities Union of the Organization of Turkic States held in Turkistan on November 23, 2022.

Definitions

Article 4 - (1) for the purpose of this Directive:

- a) Turkic Council means the Cooperation Council of Turkic Speaking States;
- b) Turkic Council Summit means Annual Meeting of the Heads of State of the Member States;
- c) Turkic Council Ministers of Education Meeting means the meeting where Ministers of Education convene. The President of Council of Higher Education of Turkey also takes part when the issues related to the Union are discussed;
- d) Secretariat means the Secretariat of the Turkic Council;
- e) Senior Officials of the Turkic Council Ministers of Education; the group composed of national experts appointed by the Ministry of Education of the Member States;
- f) Union means the Turkic University Union established under the auspices of the Turkic Council;
- g) Union of the General Assembly refers to the Committee formed with the participation of Rectors of the Member Universities or their representatives, as well as the Secretary-General of the Turkic Council or his representative;
- h) TCHEA means Turkic Council Higher Education Area.

Founding members

Article 5 - (1) Founding members of Union are the following 15 universities from four member states.

PART II

Structure and Objectives of the Union

Structure of the Union

Article 6 - (1) The Union consists of universities from member and observer states of the Organization of Turkic States and related communities.

The Union comprises the following bodies:

Chairmanship of the Union

(2) Chairman of the Union is the Secretary General of the Organization of the Turkic States.

(3) The chairmanship in-office is elected by simple majority for two years at the Meeting of the General Assembly among the member universities on a voluntary basis or with the proposal of other participants.

(4) Chairman of the Union performs his duties in coordination with Rector of Chair University-in-office in charge of academic affairs.

(5) Duties of Chair University- in-office are:

a) to host the meeting of the General Assembly of the Union and implement decisions taken at the General Assembly;

b) to provide necessary cooperation and communication in coordination with the Secretariat among the members of the Union during the chairmanship.

(6) Rector of Chair University-in-Office, in relation to his duties, shall be able to be invited to meeting of the Organization of the Turkic States Ministers of Education and/or the Organization of the Turkic States Summit.

General Assembly

(7) General Assembly of Turkic Universities Union consists of university representatives from member countries. The member university representatives are the Rector, the relevant Vice Rector and one representative from the internationalization unit.

The Board of Directors

The Secretariat

Sub-Committees

To fulfill the prioritized activities determined by the General Assembly, seven executive committees have been established:

- a) Turkic World Higher Education Databank
- b) Education-Teaching Committee
- c) Scientific Committee
- d) Turkic World Education Portal

- e) Higher Education Quality Assurance Board
- f) Sports-Culture Committee
- g) Student Council

Contact Group

(8) The Turkic Council appoints a Deputy Secretary-General while the member universities appoint a Vice-Rector together with a representative in charge of the Union activities to take part in the Contact Group.

(9) The duty of the Contact Group is to co-ordinate the implementation of the Union decisions

(10) The Contact Group meets at least twice a year.

Student Council

(11) Student Council of the Union of the is composed of students elected from the Member Universities of Union.

(12) A Directive is prepared by the Union for establishment of the Student Council, duties and responsibilities and other issues.

Objectives of the Union

Article 7 - Based on the common history, culture and language, with the aim of developing friendship and cooperation among Turkic speaking peoples and raising the level of education in order to ensure cooperation between higher education institutions of the Member States, the following objectives are to be realized:

- a) Having courses of common civilization, through the implementation of appropriate educational standards with modern scientific level in all member universities, and thus educating generations with a common identity and cultural awareness;
- b) Synchronizing higher education programs in compliance with the international accreditation standards;
- c) Establishing and implementing training programs for academic staff;
- d) Encouraging exchange of students and academic staff and making the necessary adjustments thereto;
- e) Forming a common credit transfer system;
- f) Ensuring recognition of higher education programs among the member universities and providing an appropriate basis for the recognition of each other's certification equivalence of the member universities;
- g) Benefiting from comparative superiorities of universities in certain areas;
- h) Implementing applicable cooperative education and research projects and programs, and

making publications in this field;

- i) Cooperating in social and cultural fields;
- j) Providing special scholarships for students who conduct studies on the Turkic world;
- k) Ensuring information sharing about academic studies and projects on the Turkic world electronically, and transmitting addresses of the relevant studies carried out by universities to the Secretariat website to provide them with a link on the Turkic Council website;
- l) Establishing an independent "Higher Education Quality Assurance Board" to serve for the quality assurance of external evaluation and accreditation processes of the member universities of the Union and supporting its activities.
- m) Establishing the Higher Education Databank for Organization of Turkic States members.
- n) Establishing the Turkic World Index and domain indexes.
- o) Establishing the Turkic World Education Portal.
- p) Establishing the Turkic Higher Education Area.

PART III

Working Principles of the Union, Financial Resources, Membership

Working Principles

Article 8 - (1) Decisions of the Union are taken by simple majority at the meeting of the General Assembly where Rector or representatives of the Rector of the member universities of the Union and Secretary General of the Turkic Council or his representatives shall participate.

(2) The secretarial work of the Union is carried out by Secretariat of the Turkic Council in cooperation with the Chair University-in-Office.

(3) Institutional structure, working procedures and principles with practices in financial matters of the Union are determined according to the directives to be prepared upon the decision taken with simple majority by the member universities of the Union.

(4) Decisions taken for implementation and directives prepared by the Union enter into force after their approval at the Turkic Council Ministers of Education Meeting where the President of the Higher Education Council of Turkey shall also participate.

(5) Activities of the Union shall be monitored by Senior Officials of the Turkic Council Ministers of Education including a representative of the Presidency of the Higher Education Council. The purpose of the abovementioned group is:

- a) to follow up projects planned to be implemented in the process;
- b) to ensure necessary coordination between the Member States;
- c) to carry out solutions to the problems that may arise in the process;
- d) to carry out activities in order to increase the level of acceptability and applicability

between the parties of the process;

e) To study for necessary national legislative changes for the solution of problems experienced at the national level and provide support by making recommendations to the relevant authorities.

Financial Resources of the Union

Article 9 - (1) All expenses of higher education activities to be undertaken by the Union are funded from the resources stated below:

- a) The financial resources of the member universities;
- b) Resources provided by the "Turkish Scientific Research Fund" to be established, as well as resources from national or international institutions;
- c) Additional resources that shall be provided on a project basis from universities of the Member States;
- d) Resources allocated from the budgets of Organization of the Turkic States members.

Membership to the Union

Article 10 - (1) Nomination applications are made to the Secretariat of Turkic Council with written reasons. Admission to membership and termination of membership are decided by simple majority at the meeting of the General Assembly to be held with the participation of at least two thirds of members of the Union, after receiving views of the member universities through the contact group.

PART IV

Turkic Council Higher Education Area, Processes for Implementation and Exchange Programs

Turkic World Higher Education Area

Article 11 - (1) TCHEA is the area established among the Member States and in which educational activities related to higher education is performed.

(2) TCHEA aims at achieving goals indicated in article 7 through common platforms that the Member States will establish.

Processes for Implementation

Article 12- (1) in the framework of the Turkic World Higher Education Area of the Member States of the Union need to harmonize the following items on the areas of cooperation;

- a) Exchange programs for student and academic staff;
- b) Legislation in force in their countries with regard to the opening joint certificate programs of associate, bachelor and graduate degrees implemented through formal, distance or open education.

- (2) In the framework of the cooperation to be carried out, the following items are supported by the Senior Officials of the Turkic Council Ministers of Education that shall include a representative from the Presidency of Higher Education Council of Turkey;
- a) Ensuring certificate equivalence given by the member universities of the Union and other official scientific institutions;
 - b) The utilization and promotion of tools for establishing and disseminating the Turkic World Higher Education Area are encouraged through the support of a representative from the Turkish Higher Education Council Presidency, as well as through the Senior Officials of Turkish Education Ministers.

Student and Academic Staff Mobility

Article 13 - (1) Students from other member universities are accepted to the summer and winter schools that currently operate in and/or to be opened at the member universities. Facilities to be provided to students in these programs are determined on a reciprocal basis.

(2) Orkhun Program is applied as example for the exchange of student and academic staff.

(3) Recognition of past education of students, student admission, education agreement and preparation of the transcript are organized according to a common credit system to be determined by the member universities.

PART V

Other Provisions

Issues for Which There Are No Provisions

Article 14 - Changes for the settlement of the problems that may occur for implementation of this Directive can be adopted by the General Assembly with an additional document.

Languages of the Directive

Article 15 - This Directive has been prepared in Azerbaijani, Kazakh, Kyrgyz, Turkish and English languages.

Validity

Article 16 - Provisions of this Directive enters into effect on the date of its endorsement at the Turkic Council Ministers of Education Meeting after its approval at the General Assembly of the Union.

Implementation

Article 17 - Provisions of this Directive are carried out by the Secretariat in cooperation with the Chair University-in-Office.

This process has been identified as Orkhun Program.
